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God's Servant.

AIM:

The Aim of this devotional is to assist you to have a consistent and fruitful Fellowship with The Lord while Fasting this January.

The Foundation you lay for Building is what determines the Structure you can put up on top of it. This is the time to lay a solid Foundation not only for the year 2020 but also for the decade ahead. Build it with the Word of God and Reinforce it with Strong Prayers.

By taking the time out at the beginning of each year to fast and Pray, you can align with God's plans and purposes for your life through that year. You will be guided to study in depth and pray effectively the kind of Prayer God answers.

2020 is unlike most years. It is the beginning of a very critical Decade, the 3rd one, of this Millennium and you should take this very seriously.

Main Scripture:

Our foundation Scripture for the year is from Isaiah 54:10 (NLT) – “For the mountains may move and the hills disappear, but even then My Faithful Love for you will remain. My Covenant of Blessing will never be broken.” says The LORD who has Mercy on you.

There you have an amazing Promise from The Lord. I pray that through this Solemn Fast, you will build up and strengthen your faith to believe what God has said about you. You will declare it in all areas of your life while expecting the full manifestations of it.

Most importantly, I pray that through these 21 days, you will get closer to God by studying and meditating upon His Holy Word and spending quality time before Him in your Prayers.

I always encourage believers to keep a Prayer journal close by and write down everything The receive from The Lord during Fasting and Prayers. Some will make immediate sense to you, others will be for the days ahead. Write them all down including your dreams. Write them as soon as you can so you won't forget them.

DAY 1

Repentance from sins and all dead works that do not glorify God



Bible reading:

Psalms 66:18

“If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me”.

1 John 1:8-9

“If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness”

The Bible describes God as three times Holy in Isaiah 6. To that extent therefore, God cannot tolerate sin in His Holy Presence. Psalms 66:18 goes as far as to say that God will not even hear your Prayers or cries if there is sin in you. That’s the truth.

Thank God for Jesus, who is the propitiation for our sins and by whom we can approach The Father with confidence knowing that we stand forgiven of all sins in Christ.

It is therefore beneficial to ask God in the Name of Jesus to forgive your sins and cleanse you from all unrighteousness as we start the Fast.

This sets your mind free from all guilt and accusations of the enemy.

Further Reading: Psalms 51

- Pray and sincerely repent of anything you can recall which you know does not glorify or please The Lord, tell Him you are sorry and ask Him to forgive you.
- Pray for others who may be struggling with one issue or the other in their lives
- While asking God to forgive your sins against Him, forgive those who have sinned against you. (Matthew 6:14-15)
- Thank God for His mercy and for forgiving you.
- Believe that you are forgiven and rejoice before Him. It is also important to ask for grace not to repeat those things for which you have been forgiven,


DAY 2

Prayer of Adoration

Bible reading:

Psalms 149

Praise the Lord! Sing to the Lord a new song, And His praise in the assembly of saints. Let Israel rejoice in their Maker; Let the children of Zion be joyful in their King. Let them praise His name with the dance; Let them sing praises to Him with the timbrel and harp. For the Lord takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the humble with salvation. Let the saints be joyful in glory; Let them sing aloud on their beds. Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, And a two-edged sword in their hand, To execute vengeance on the nations, And punishments on the peoples; To bind their kings with chains, And their nobles with fetters of iron; To execute on them the written judgment—This honor have all His saints. Praise the Lord!



The Book of Psalms is filled with very many powerful chapters that are devoted to the adoration of The Almighty God. This was the secret of King David and is the most Powerful form of Prayer.

Today, spend quality time to celebrate God. Declare His majesty. Tell Him how great He is, how Powerful He is, how Faithful He is. Worship and adore God. Rejoice in His presence. Do not ask for anything for yourself only let your heart be filled with Praises and adoration for Him.


DAY 3

Prayer of Thanksgiving

Bible reading:

Ps 50:7-14 (TLB)

O my people, listen! For I am your God. Listen! Here are my charges against you: I have no complaint about the sacrifices you bring to my altar, for you bring them regularly. But it isn't sacrificial bullocks and goats that I really want from you. For all the animals of field and forest are mine! The cattle on a thousand hills! And all the birds upon the mountains! If I were hungry, I would not mention it to you—for all the world is mine and everything in it. No, I don't need your sacrifices of flesh and blood. What I want from you is your true thanks; I want your promises fulfilled. I want you to trust me in your times of trouble, so I can rescue you and you can give me glory.



One of the main causes of discouragement is when we keep asking God for things after things without stopping to thank Him for the ones He has done. Thanking God is so important that Our Lord Jesus stopped to ask a question, after He had healed 10 Lepers and only one returned to give God thanks (Luke 17). In Psalms 50, God says what I want from you is true thanks or sincere and consistent thanksgiving. When you thank God, you honour Him for His blessings upon your life. When you remember what He has done for you and praise His Name for those things, your faith is strengthened and you can trust that He will do the other things He has promised to do for you. God loves this. Every parent will identify with this. We love it when our children appreciate what we have done for them. Friendships, Marriages are strengthened when each partner is thankful for what the other does. A grateful heart is a healthy heart.

Today, read aloud words or thanksgivings to God. Throughout the day, whenever you remember what The Lord has done for you, stop and give Him thanks

DAY 4

Marriages.
Families. Children
and Youths.



Bible reading:

Genesis 2:18

And the Lord God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him."

Over the next 4 Days we shall focus our Prayers on Relationships, families etc. The home is not only the bedrock of society but also the bedrock of the Church.

In most communities in the world today, we have broken homes and relationships and the evidence can easily be seen in the world today. It is the will of God for His children to be happily married, raise godly children and serve God together as a family.

Today: Let us remember the brothers and sisters among us and outside the Church who are believing God for the blessing of Marriage.

- Pray that the Lord will order their steps to the individuals with whom they can live happily together.
- Pray that their faith be strengthened whilst they wait on God
- Pray that their discernment be sharpened to avoid mistakes
- Pray for those in relationships already that The Lord will provide for them and help them understand one another as they plan to build their lives together
- Pray that in 2020 Nu – Life will conduct many marriages.

DAY 5

Pray for Marriages

Bible reading:

Ephesians 5:21-33 (nlt)

And further, submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

For wives, this means submit to your husbands as to the Lord. For a husband is the head of his wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of his body, the church. As the church submits to Christ, so you wives should submit to your husbands in everything.----- For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her to make her holy and clean, washed by the cleansing of God's word.----- As the Scriptures say, "A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one." This is a great mystery, but it is an illustration of the way Christ and the church are one. So, again I say, each man must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.



There is a growing problem in the society today and unfortunately, it has crept into the Church at an alarming rate. There is a gross misunderstanding of the roles of husbands and wives in Marriages. The Lord God never gave one any authority to lord over another. Ephesians 5:21 clearly commands that we submit to one another "out of reverence for Christ"

Wives are required to submit to their own husbands "as to the Lord". This goes beyond what the world says. This is God's order. It does not make the man superior to the woman but places the man in a position of leadership over the home so there will be order in the family. The man is to love his wife as Christ loves the Church and gave Himself for her. This is by far much more responsibility on the husband. I am still convinced that no Christian woman will struggle to yield the leadership of their home to a husband that places her over himself, seeking her good and that of their children before his. Not a man who controls and suppresses a woman. That is not a Christian husband.

Today:

- Pray for Peace and understanding and love for all the Christian couples you know
- Pray that any union that may be going through a crisis will obtain God's wisdom in resolving the issues.
- Pray against all activities of satan against marriages and homes
- Pray for broken homes that somehow, God will intervene and help the affected members of the family to find direction for their lives.

DAY 6

Pray for Parents

Bible reading:

Proverbs 22:6 (nkjv)

Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Ephesians 6:1-4 (nlt)

Children obey your parents because you belong to the Lord, for this is the right thing to do. "Honor your father and mother." This is the first commandment with a promise: If you honor your father and mother, "things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth." Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger by the way you treat them. Rather, bring them up with the discipline and instruction that comes from the Lord.



One of the most important duties any person can undertake in life is to raise up a child. This is ground zero when it comes to the enemy's battle for the soul of society and the Church. The current culture is completely anti God's way and the enemy loves it that way. The Scripture above (Prov. 22:6) teaches that it is the duty of the Parents to "Train up" children. I like the phrase used there – Train up!

A child who is properly trained up in the way of God ends up a Leading member of society. Fathers are asked not to provoke their children to anger by the way you treat them. Children respond to love and will accept rebuke and correction when offered in love.

God says Children should honor their parents. This is the first commandment with an added blessing.

Today:

- Pray for Single parents in our midst and in our community, they have a particularly challenging yet vital role in moulding the future of our world.
- Pray for Parents that God will give them wisdom and the grace to relate with their children as it pleases the Lord.
- Pray for our Children. May Christ be fully formed in them. May they continue in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. Loving and serving The Lord all the days of their lives

DAY 7

Prayer for Teenagers and Youths



Bible reading:

Psalms 144:12 (nlt)

May our sons flourish in their youth, like well-nurtured plants. May our daughters be like graceful pillars, carved to beautify a palace.

Everyone who has experienced raising children will tell you that the most challenging period is likely during their teens and early twenties. Many homes and even marriages have been negatively impacted due in part to this situation. Some parents tend to see their teens as rebellious while the Teens see their parents as lacking in understanding and old fashioned. Truth is that the world is changing so fast and most of the mentoring our young ones receive are not from their parents. This can be both good and bad depending upon other factors.

God so designed the home to be the place where children including teens receive mentoring and nurture from the wisdom, experiences and skills of their parents. Where conflict exists, the enemy normally hides behind minor issues to create the divide so the young ones are starved of what they really need for their lives. The Bible teaches that children are prone to mistakes. This does not mean they are foolish all the time. Expect them to make their mistakes yet love them enough for them to trust you and seek wisdom from you.

Today:

- Pray for parents and families who are raising teenage children and youths. Ask God to grant them wisdom for this all-important assignment.
- Pray against the knife and gun violence that is aimed at the youth in our nation today. Separate our children from untimely death
- Pray that The Lord will lead them away from mistakes that could damage their lives and destinies
- Pray for godly friends for our young ones. The company they keep is important
- Pray that the Love and fear of God will continually be put in their hearts by the Holy Spirit.

DAY 8

Prayer for Spiritual growth



Bible reading:

1 Corinthians 3:1-3 (nkjv)

And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ. I fed you with milk and not with solid food; for until now you were not able to receive it, and even now you are still not able; for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men?

Galatians 4:1-2 (nkjv)

Now I say that the heir, as long as he is a child, does not differ at all from a slave, though he is master of all, but is under guardians and stewards until the time appointed by the father.

When a child is born in a family, everyone expects the baby to “be a child”. That means there is a natural expectation for the baby to behave, react and act in a certain way. Parents, especially Mothers have a special ability to interpret the baby’s words, actions and reactions accurately and to respond accordingly. However, as time passes, the child is expected to out-grow certain behaviours and tendencies. If a child still cries hysterically at 10 years of age when it is time to eat rather than tell the Mum or Dad, then something is not quite right.

God expects you to grow or mature in your walk with Him.

Responsibilities including managing God’s Blessings are designed for mature Christians.

Growth does not happen automatically but from consistent intentional actions

- Daily and consistent Study and Meditation in God’s Word
- Worshipping and Praising God in the beauty of holiness
- Constant and continuous Prayers
- Be an active Member of a local Church and fellowship with other Believers regularly.
- Volunteering to Serve in your local Church
- Giving of your resources like Time, Skills, Finances etc. to support the work of the kingdom of God

The enemy will deprive you of your God-given blessings if you choose to remain a child.

Today:

- Pray for a stronger desire and hunger for growth and maturity in the things of God in your life this year.
- I have listed a few things above, which you could do to support you in your journey. Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to guide you. Just do them then watch and see what God will do in your life this year.

DAY 9

Prayer for Growth in the knowledge of God's Word

Bible reading:

1 Peter 2:2 nkjv

Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby, if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious.

2 Peter 3:17-18 (nkjv)

You therefore, beloved, since you know this beforehand, beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked; but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.



One the greatest benefits you could derive from this time of Fasting is to search out a massive collection of God's promises to you from His Holy Word. There is a Promise for your marriage in the Bible. There is a Promise for your Health. There is a Promise for your Finances and even the area of your calling or ministry. These will keep you, guide you and strengthen your Faith for the rest of the year and beyond. When you have a revealed Promise from God to you, it sharpens your expectation and uplifts your hope.

Today:

- Pray for the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the knowledge of God's Word (Ephsians 1) and seek to store up for yourself these revelations
- Pray for An increase in the Knowledge of God's Word which means an increase in your Knowledge of Jesus Christ. This brings stability in your Faith.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to grant you understanding as you study His Word and the mental capacity to retain or store up God's word in your heart

DAY 10

Prayer for Strength, Courage and the Grace to be Obedient to God. These come before Good Success.

Bible reading:

Joshua 1:7-9 (nkjv)

Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.”



There are 12 phrases that immediately stand out from the above verses of Scripture. Be Strong. Be of good Courage. Observe to do. Don't turn from it. That you may Prosper wherever you go. Meditate in it. Day and Night. You will make your way prosperous. You will have good success. Do not be afraid. Do not be discouraged (dismayed). The Lord your God is with you.

Over the next 4 days, I ask you to take up 3 for each day and pray them into being an integral part of your life this year and beyond. The Lord promises to give you not just success but good success. This is what you need in this decade.

Today:

- Ask The Lord for **strength** for the journey. You will need strength against all the strategies of the evil one (Ephesians 6:10)
- Pray for **Courage** in your life. Dictionary.com defines Courage as “the quality of mind or spirit that enables a person to face difficulty, danger, pain, etc., without fear. Bravery.
- It is not enough to know what God says, it is even more important **to obey or do** what He commands. Pray for speed of obedience and the necessary grace.

DAY 11

Pray for Good Success and not just any Success, this Decade.

Bible reading:

Joshua 1:7-9 (nkjv)

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Today:

- Pray for a steadfast spirit. Commitment without wavering. **Consistency.** A double minded man cannot receive anything from God
- Ask The Lord to **prosper every area of your life.** The idea of prosperity in the kingdom is totally different from that of the world. God wants to bless you so that you may be a blessing to His kingdom and others. It's much more than money and physical wealth
- Ask The Holy Spirit to help you meditate on His Word. To meditate is to think about what you have read, to contemplate what you have read and to reflect upon what you have read. It requires spending more time on the Word.

DAY 12

Consistency in Serving God comes before Good Success.

Decide to be Consistent with Jesus this decade and receive Good Success.

Bible reading:

Joshua 1:7-9 (nkjv)

Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."



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Today:

- Ask The Lord for His Grace upon you to be **faithful** to Him. In season and out of season. Many worship God, go to Church or Serve God when everything is good, the sun is shining. God wants you to serve Him, to worship, to fellowship with others whether the sun shines or not.
- Notice here that it says, "you will then make your way prosperous". Ask for the grace of God so you will do the necessary this year to guarantee the results you desire.
- You should never pray for just success but pray for Good Success this year

DAY 13

Pray against the spirit of fear in your life.

You will not make decisions this decade out of fear.

Bible reading:

Joshua 1:7-9 (nkjv)

Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."



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If there is one thing the enemy uses to defeat the children of God, it is fear. Fear is doubting God's commitment to His Word and Promises. Fear is accepting that whatever you are facing is too hard for the Lord. Fear is what leads to discouragement. Faith is absent where fear is prevalent and God only responds to Faith.

Today:

- Pray against the spirit of fear in your life. Read Isaiah 41, 54 and get my teachings on it
- Rebuke any suggestion of discouragement from your heart. The combination of these two is lethal against your Faith. Faith generates Hope which is the anchor for your souls. Fear generates discouragement. Cast it out in Jesus Name.
- Say repeatedly throughout this year and whenever trouble comes – “ I am not alone. I am not in trouble. I will not fail. The Lord my God is with me as a Mighty one in battle”

DAY 14

Prayers for Our Church and the Body of Christ

This next 3 days, let us intercede intensely for the local assembly God has planted us in



Bible reading:

Matthew 16:16-19 (nkjv)

Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Many scholars are debating whether the Body of Christ has experienced a greater dimension of resistance and attacks during past generations like we currently are. The truth is that each generation has to experience it's own measure of persecution. With the advent of 24 hour news cycles and the internet, especially fake news, it is clear that there is a massive war going on presently against the Truth and the Body of Christ. Read the news with a discerning mind and let The Lord help you and you will discover that the aim of the enemy is to discredit the Church, the Holy Bible and Christianity.

The good news is that Christ has declared the victory for His church and there is nothing the enemy can do about it. However, we have to enforce this victory in prayers

Today:

- Pray for The body of Christ globally and Nu- Life Church in particular that we will continue to proclaim the unvarnished Truth of God's Word unhindered.
- Join with the rest of the Body of Christ and declare that no weapon of the enemy fashioned against the Church will stand
- Ask the Holy Spirit to protect Pastors and Missionaries globally and your Pastors in particular against the attacks of the enemy and preserve them and meet their needs
- Pray for the persecuted Church in China, Africa and other places where freedom of worship is restricted.


DAY 15

Pray for greater Manifestation of God's Mighty Power in our midst

Bible reading:

Mark 16:14-18 (nkjv)

Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen. And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."



The great Commission comes with the mandate for signs and wonders and the performance of Miracles by every believer in Christ. This is why we are anointed by The Holy Spirit. If you are not healing the sick, casting out devils, setting the captives free and leading sinners to salvation, you are not yet fulfilling the great Commission.

Today:

- Ask God for the anointing of God to be manifest in your life with signs and wonders following
- Pray that the glory of God will fall at each worship service in Church with the evidence of Salvation of sinners, healing of the sick and deliverance of all who are oppressed by the devil. No one will come in with any challenges and leave without hope.
- Today, join together and let's speak healing and deliverance upon anyone amongst us who is presently being oppressed in any way by the enemy


DAY 16

Pray for more
Workers (co-
labourers with
Christ) in the
vineyard

Bible reading:

Matthew 9:35-38 (nkjv)

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."



- Pray for more people to join the ranks of volunteers serving the Lord in whatever area of calling is upon their lives (1 Corinthians 12 & 14)
- Pray for Souls this year. We have done well but we must persevere to reach more for the Lord this year. Everyone should endeavour to Invite and Establish at least one soul in the first quarter of 2020
- Ask The Lord to use you this 2020 and beyond to reach more for The kingdom


DAY 17

Prayer for Finances

Bible reading:

Deuteronomy 8:11-18 (nkjv)

“Beware that you do not forget the Lord your God by not keeping His commandments, His judgments, and His statutes which I command you today, lest—when you have eaten and are full, and have built beautiful houses and dwell in them; and when your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold are multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied; when your heart is lifted up, and you forget the Lord your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage; who led you through that great and terrible wilderness, in which were fiery serpents and scorpions and thirsty land where there was no water; who brought water for you out of the flinty rock; who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do you good in the end— then you say in your heart, ‘My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.’
“And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.



From the above Scripture, remember this was to be foundational in the life of Israel as a Nation, God wanted His people to know and trust Him as their source. He also wanted them to serve Him with the resources He blesses them. This is how the Kingdom operates and when we operate outside of this principle, we miss out on God's best for us

Today:

- Thank God for His Financial blessings upon your life. Acknowledge Him as your source. It is He who has given you the power to get wealth in whatever area of endeavour you are engaged in
- Pray for clarity from God on how He wants you to support the work of God this year. Remember, Our Lord Jesus taught that it is more blessed to give than to receive.
- The Bible says, oh taste and see that The Lord is Good. Start your complete obedience today by sending in your Tithes and your weekly freewill Offerings. This is the Power that activate the Covenant of Financial Blessings with God's peace in your life. (Luke 6:38)


DAY 18

God has Promised to Meet your every need.

Bible reading:

2 Corinthians 9:6 – 11 (nkjv)

But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God



When Christians struggle with giving it is largely because they fail to trust in God's covenant Promises to meet every need in their lives. This must not be your portion in this year and beyond. God wants you to be a cheerful giver. Notice here that it is not the amount but the attitude that matters to God. This Fasting period is the best time to start to exercise your faith in this area if you have been struggling there. God wants you to serve Him with all your heart, soul and mind. All of you. Not just a part of your life. Join the innumerable company of believers who have tasted and proven that God is indeed our Faithful Promise keeper.

Today:

- Pray and receive Faith to obey God in your giving. Ask and receive a generous spirit from The Lord. Practice your generosity
- Pray for the finances of your family also. We must all depend upon God
- Pray for the Finances of Nu-Life Church. Our vision is clear. Our New Church Building, a befitting place of worship is due this 2020.
- Ask The Lord to raise helpers from far and near, including you that this will be done effortlessly and without too much stress.

DAY 19

Spiritual Warfare

Bible reading:

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 (NKJV)

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not [a]carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,



Satan's major strategy of deception is to work through deluding, seducing, lying spirits so that he can divert you away from the plan and purpose that God has for your life. His objective is to lead you into rebellion against God where you reject God's will and follow your own self will. (1 Timothy 4:1-2).

Satan will use every possible means to deceive and fill your mind with lies that will cause you to live your life after the dictates of your carnal nature and the system of this world. We are called to resist him steadfast in faith

In the above scripture you will notice that the apostle Paul exhorts us to use God's weapons to do God's work. Therefore, in dealing with the spirit of deception we as believers must choose to use God's methods.

Today:

- Pray that you will demolish every deceptive spirit that opposes God and breakthrough every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God.
- Ask the Lord to rid your mind of Satan's delusions and lies.
- Ask The Lord for the power to discern and cast out the spirits that are attacking your mind and that of other believers.
- Pray that you hold fast to the truth of God's Word and that you will capture every thought and insist that it bow in obedience to Christ the Anointed one.

DAY 20

Pray for Love to abound and be seen in our homes and Church continuously.

Bible reading:

1 Peter 4:8 (AMPC)

Above all things have intense and unfailing love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins [forgives and [a]disregards the offenses of others].

1 Corinthians 13:4 (NIV)

Love is patient, love is kind.

1 Corinthians 13:5 (AMPC)

Love (God's love in us)... is not touchy or fretful or resentful...



Jesus taught us that by loving one another, others will see us and know that we are His disciples indeed (John 13). God is Love and we are His offsprings.

Love, Patience and kindness are the embodiment of the nature of God.

The Law of Love is the Royal Law of the Kingdom of God. Jesus said that the world will know that we are his children by the love we have for one another. This is not the natural human love, but the agape love that is symbolic of our God. We are required to try and understand one another and put ourselves in each other's shoes, attempting to see things from the other person's point of view and not just from our own. If we did this, we would develop a very different mind-set and become kinder and more tolerant.

Today:

- Pray that the nature of God will grow in you, your family and the brethren so that we can deal with others in a patient and kind manner.
- Let us pray that we develop the love of God so that we can operate according to this scripture.
- Becoming offended is a tool of the enemy to ensnare us. Let us pray that we do not give the devil a place by responding to things by becoming touchy, fretful or resentful.

DAY 21

To Crown this year's Fasting and Prayers, spend the day in Thanking God for answered Prayers


Bible reading:
